Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

""What must I do to inherit eternal life?" Mark 10:17

Today's Liturgy offers us the encounter between Jesus and a man who "had great possessions" (Mk 10:22). His encounter with Jesus, in fact, allows us to test our faith.

"Faith is a question of freedom - it is a question of love. What is faith for me? If it

is mainly a duty or a bargaining chip - then, we are off track. Faith is born from a look of love to be welcomed. It is based on God's gaze. Look for God's gaze: sit in adoration, allow yourself to be forgiven in Confession, stand before the Crucified One. In short, let yourself be loved by Him. This is the starting point of faith: letting oneself be loved by Him, by the Father. Finally, Jesus invites us to do the maximum possible. Christian life is a "yes" a "yes" of love.

A faith without giving, a faith without gratuitousness is an incomplete faith. It makes us sad in the end: just like that man whose "face fell" and returned home "sorrowful", even though he had been looked upon with love by Jesus in person. Today we can ask ourselves: "At what point is my faith? Do I experience it as something mechanical, like a relationship of duty or interest with God? Do I remember to nourish it by letting myself be looked at and loved by Jesus?" Letting oneself be looked at and loved by Jesus; letting Jesus look at us, love us. "Do I respond freely, with generosity, with all my heart?"." Oct 10, 2021

May the Virgin Mary, who said a total "yes" to God pray for us. May we savour the beauty of making life a gift.


XVIth Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops is currently




