### SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2024

#### Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.... You shall love your neighbour as yourself." Mk 12:30-31

The heart of this Sunday's Gospel passage is the commandment of love - love of God and love of neighbour.

"In choosing these two Words addressed by God to His people and by putting them together, Jesus taught once and for all that love for God and love for neighbour are inseparable; moreover, they sustain one another. To love God is to live of Him and for Him, for what He is and for



what He does.

If we practice seeing with Jesus' gaze, we will always be listening and be close to those in need. Today's Gospel passage invites

*us all to be projected not only toward the needs of our poorest brothers and sisters, but above all to be attentive to their need for fraternal closeness, for a meaning to life, and for tenderness.* 

God, who is love, created us to love and so that we can love others while remaining united with Him. It would be misleading to claim to love our neighbour without loving God; and it would also be deceptive to claim to love God without loving our neighbour. The two dimensions of love, for God and for neighbour, in their unity characterize the disciple of Christ." Nov 4, 2018 May the Virgin Mary help us to welcome and bear witness in everyday life to this luminous lesson.
