## Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

# **SUNDAY, JULY 2, 2023**

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time "Whoever welcomes You welcomes Me, and whoever welcomes Me welcomes the one who sent Me." (Matt 10:40-42). Jesus underscores two essential aspects for the life of a missionary disciple...the bond with Jesus is stronger than any other bond and the missionary brings not himself/herself, but Jesus, and through Him the love of the Heavenly Father. "Those who allow themselves to be drawn into this bond of love and of life with the Lord Jesus become His representatives, His "ambassadors", above all in the way of being - of living. To the point that Jesus Himself, in sending His disciples on a mission, says to them: "He who receives you receives Me, and he/she who receives Me receives Him who sent me" (Mt 10:40). It is important that the people be able to perceive that for that disciple Jesus is truly "the Lord"; He is truly the centre of his or *her life - the everything of life.* 

One must also be honest with oneself and with others. This is why Jesus prays to the Father so that the disciples may not fall prey to the worldly spirit. You are either with Jesus, with the spirit of Jesus, or you are with the spirit of the world." July221,2017 The Virgin Mary felt in the first person what it means to love Jesus by separating herself from Him, giving new meaning to family ties, beginning with faith in Him. With her maternal intercession, may she help us to be free and happy missionaries of the Gospel.

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the



#### Adsumus, Sancte Spírítus Bishops welcome Synod Working
