

"Large crowds were travelling with Him" Luke 24:25



To travel with Jesus means to follow Him, to become His disciples.

"The Lord's message was quite demanding. Whomever

does not love Him more than his or her own family, whoever does not carry the cross, whoever remains attached to earthly goods, cannot be His disciple (cf. vv. 26-27.33). Many were attracted by His words, astonished at the things He did, and saw Him as a source of hope for the future.

The Gospel tells us that this is not Jesus' way. Instead of yielding to the allure of popularity He asks each person to discern carefully their reason for following Him and the consequences that it will entail.

The Lord demands a different attitude. To follow Him means "carrying one's cross" (Lk 14:27): making one's life a gift and spending it in imitation of His own generous and merciful love for us.

To do this, we need to look to Him more than to ourselves - to learn how to love. It means sharing His merciful love, entering His great work of mercy for each and every one of us. The work of Jesus is, precisely, a work of mercy, a work of forgiveness and of love!" Sept. 8, 2013


