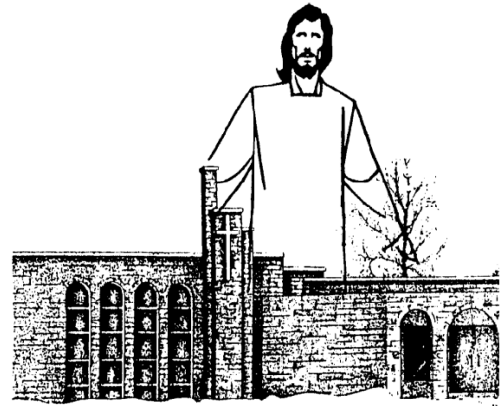

The Most Holy Trinity

“All that the Father has is mine. For this reason I said that He (Holy Spirit) will take what is mine and declare it to you.” John 16:15



The Gospel of St John gives us part of the long farewell discourse pronounced by Jesus shortly before His Passion. He explains to the disciples the deepest truths about Himself, and thus He outlines the relationship between Jesus, the Father and the Holy Spirit. “Jesus knows that the fulfilment of the Father’s plan is approaching and will be completed with His death and resurrection. Because of this He wants to assure His followers that He won’t abandon them. It will be the Holy Spirit who continues the mission of Jesus and will guide the Church forward.

Through baptism, the Holy Spirit has placed us in the heart and the very life of God, who is a communion of love. God is a “family” of three Persons who love each other so much as to form a single whole. The Trinity is not a theological riddle, but rather the splendid mystery of God’s closeness. The Trinity tells us that we do not have a solitary God above in Heaven, distant and indifferent; no, He is Father who gave us His Son, who became man like us, and who, in order to be even closer to us, to help us bear the burdens of life, sends us His very Spirit. He, who is Spirit, enters our spirit and thus comforts us from within, bringing God’s tenderness into our heart. With God the burdens of life do not rest on our shoulders: the Spirit, whom we name each time we make the sign of the Cross precisely as we touch our shoulders, comes to give us strength, to encourage us, to bear the burdens.” June 16, '19

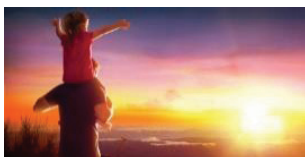

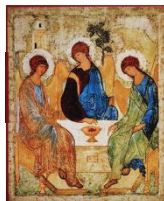
