### Pentecost Sunday

*When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. Acts 2:1* In the first reading, the Spirit makes of the disciples a new people; in the Gospel, He creates in the disciples a new heart.



*“The Spirit is far from being an abstract reality: He is the Person who is most concrete and close, the one who changes our lives. How does He do this? Let us consider the Apostles. The Holy Spirit did not make things easier for them, He didn’t work spectacular miracles, He didn’t take away their difficulties and their opponents. Rather, the Spirit brought into the lives of the disciples a harmony that had been lacking, His own harmony, for He is harmony.*

*Harmony within human beings. Deep down, in their hearts, the disciples needed to be changed. Their story teaches us that even seeing the Risen Lord is not enough, unless we welcome Him into our hearts. It is no use knowing that the Risen One is alive, unless, we too, live as risen ones. It is the Spirit who makes Jesus live within us; He raises us up from within.*

*The Holy Spirit does not bring only harmony within us but also among us. We differ in the variety of our qualities and gifts. The Holy Spirit distributes them creatively, so that they are not all identical. On the basis of this variety, He builds unity. Let us daily implore the gift of the Spirit!” June 9,2019*
