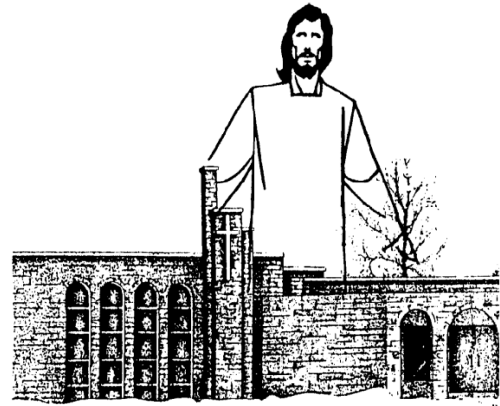

Corpus Christi



“Whoever eats My flesh and drinks my blood abides in Me, and I in them.” John 6:56

On this Solemnity of Corpus Domini, the idea of memory comes up again and again. Today, to each of us, the word of God says, Remember!

“Remembrance of the Lord’s deeds

guided and strengthened His people’s journey through the desert. Remembering all that the Lord has done for us is the foundation of our own personal history of salvation.

Remembrance is essential for faith. Faith cannot stay alive and bear fruit, unless it drinks deeply of the memory of all that the Lord has done for us. “Remember Jesus Christ.”

Memory is important, because it allows us to dwell in love - never forgetting who it is who loves us and whom we are called to love in return. The Eucharist is the memorial of God’s love. There, “[Christ’s] sufferings are remembered”.

When we receive the Eucharist, our hearts are overcome with the certainty of Jesus’ love. The Eucharist gives us a grateful memory, because it makes us see that we are the Father’s children, whom He loves and nourishes.

The Eucharist encourages us: even on the roughest road, we are not alone. The Lord does not forget us and whenever we turn to Him, He restores us with His love. The Eucharist also reminds us that we are not isolated individuals, but one body. Let us adore and thank the Lord for this greatest of gifts: the living memorial of His love, that makes us one body and leads us to unity.” Jun 18, ‘17

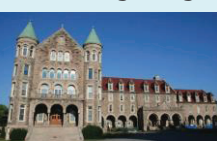

The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary - June 13th, 2026

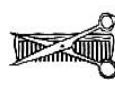
