

"If you had faith the size of a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Luke 17:6 "Lord, increase our faith! A beautiful prayer, which we should pray often throughout the day!"

"Faith compared to the mustard seed is a faith that is not proud and self-confident; and

doesn't pretend to be that of a great believer! It is a faith that in its humility feels a great need for God and in its smallness it abandons itself with total confidence to God. 


