

Christ the King

"You say that I am a king...Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to My voice." John 18:37

Today's Gospel leads us to contemplate Jesus as He introduces Himself to Pilate as King of a kingdom that "is not of this world" (Jn 18:36).



"The logic of Jesus, is expressed in humility and gratuitousness. It is silently but effectively affirmed with the strength of truth. The

kingdoms of this world at times are sustained by arrogance, rivalries and oppression; the reign of Christ is a "kingdom of justice, love and peace".

When did Jesus reveal himself as king? In the event of the Cross! Those who look at the Cross cannot but see the astonishing gratuitousness of love. For a Christian, speaking of power and strength means referring to the power of the Cross, and the strength of Jesus' love: a love which remains steadfast and complete.

Let each one of us say in his or her heart: "He gave His life for me, in order to save each one of us from our sins". The kingship of Jesus doesn't oppress us, but rather frees us from our weaknesses and miseries, encouraging us to walk the path of the good, of reconciliation and of forgiveness. "Jesus, remember me when You come into Your kingdom"." Nov 22, 2015

Let us ask the Virgin Mary to sustain us in our commitment to emulate Jesus, our king, by making His kingdom present with gestures of tenderness, understanding and mercy.


