#### Marriage


Contact the Pastor at least six months prior to the wedding. A preparation course is required.

#### Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"For no one who does a mighty work in my name will be able soon after



to speak evil of me. For he that is not against us is for us." Mark 9:39-40

Jesus wants to educate His disciples — and us today — on this inner freedom. "Jesus appears very free, fully open to

the freedom of the Spirit of God, whose actions are not limited by any confines nor boundaries.

John and the other disciples display a 'closed' attitude when faced with a circumstance that does not fit with their programme. The disciples' attitude is very human, very common, and we can observe this in Christian communities throughout history, probably in ourselves as well. It is good for us to reflect on this episode and to perform a small examination of conscience.

The Church grows by bearing witness to others with the strength of the Holy Spirit. God's great freedom in giving Himself to us encourages us to go beyond - to open our hearts in order to be able to recognize God's presence and action, even in unusual and unpredictable environments that are not part of our circle." May the Virgin Mary, an example of docile openness to God's surprises, help us to recognize the signs of the Lord's presence in our midst, so that we may find Him everywhere He manifests Himself, even in the most unthinkable and unusual situations. 


