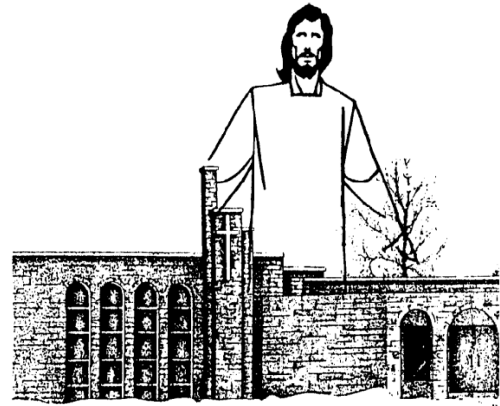

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Jesus was teaching in the temple and a large crowd was listening to Him...” Mk 12:38

Today Jesus tells us that life's benchmark is not quantity but fullness – there is a difference.

“Think about the difference there is between quantity and fullness. You can have a lot of money and still be empty. There is no fullness in your heart.

There is a difference between the wallet and the heart.

There are diseases of the heart, which reduce the heart to the wallet.... This is not good!



To love God “with all your heart” means to trust in Him, in His providence, and to serve Him in the poorest brothers and sisters without expecting anything in return.

Faced with the needs of our

neighbours, we are called to deprive ourselves of essential things - not only the superfluous. We are called to give the time that is necessary, not just what is extra. We are called to give immediately and unconditionally some of our talent, not after using it for our own purposes or for our own group.

Our “giving” to God in prayer and to others in charity” must be an expression of gratitude - as Jesus did with us. He saved us freely. And we must do things as an expression of gratitude. This is why Jesus points to the poor, generous, humble widow as a model of Christian life to be imitated.” Nov 8, 2015

Through the intercession of Mary let us ask for a heart that is poor, but rich in glad and freely given generosity.

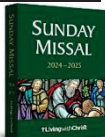

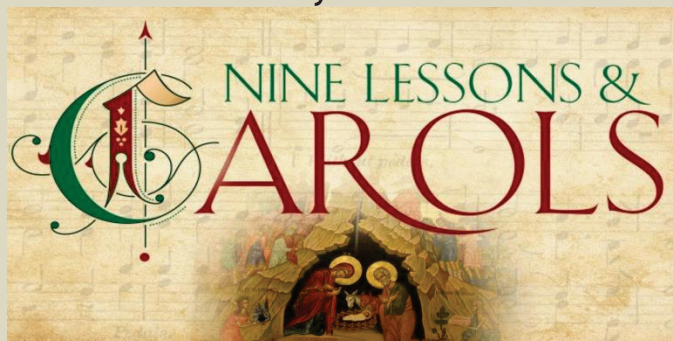
